Methodist Women The Christmas season is officially here! This year the times are much different, and we may have difficulty feeling the spirit of the season, but there is great joy in rejoicing the birth of our Lord. May your Christmas season be filled with peace, comfort and joy!

In November we held our annual Thanksgiving Food Drive, which supports our church's food pantry clients. THANK YOU to everyone who participated in this year's Thanksgiving food drive! We had an extremely successful collection. This year, we filled bags of Thanksgiving staples for 17 families. Our donors were so generous, we had funds leftover. In addition to the food for the seventeen families, we donated close to \$175 to the LFUMC Food Pantry- which will be used to continue to fund the food pantry. Thank you Linda Timms for all your hard work organizing the collection, shopping, overseeing the packing of the bags and ensuring that every family received what was needed. Thank you Mary Riker for providing the funds to purchase the 17 turkey breasts. Without your donation, we wouldn't have been able to make the additional donation to the food pantry.

Members of the UMW once again participated in Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child in November. This year, participants sent a total of fifteen shoeboxes to children throughout the world to help spread the Word of God. Thank you to those who participated.
